Community Raising May House of Joy

The May House of Joy is the culmination of 10 years of planning between Asias Children and Ahtee Bya (John Bee), a tribal leader in Thailand. The May House of Joy was built by the cooperation of many churches along the Mula River in SE Asia with support from Asias Children. The churches have decided the May House of Joy will be used as an orphanage (capacity 24), evangelism center, medical office, drug treatment center, church planting office, leadership development training and as an education Center.

Asias Children helps with Lisu Bible Institute

The Lisu Bible Institute is a Bible College that accepts students from the Kachin, Lahu, Rawang and Lisu tribes of northern Thailand. Leaders from 57 Lisu churches oversee the operation of the college. Asias Children funded scholarships for five Burmese students who would not otherwise have been able to afford this education. The Lisu Bible Institute was founded in 1999 by Jesse Yangmi (1940-2020) to provide Christian pastors and teachers to Lisu churches in Asia.

Doi Saket Children's Home

Doi Saket Children's Home was founded in 2012 and can accommodate 12 orphaned or at-risk children. Asias Children provided funding for kitchen and bathroom upgrades during the last year. Currently closed because of Covid, the home plans to accept three children when conditions improve.

One thousand orphans live in villages along the Mula River in SE Asia. Covid related economic effects drove a subsistence economy into malnutrition. Asias Children worked through existing churches in the region to supply food, masks and other aid to this distressed region. Much more needs to be done. Asias Children is the only outside organization working in this region and has provided over three thousand dollars towards this effort during the last year.
